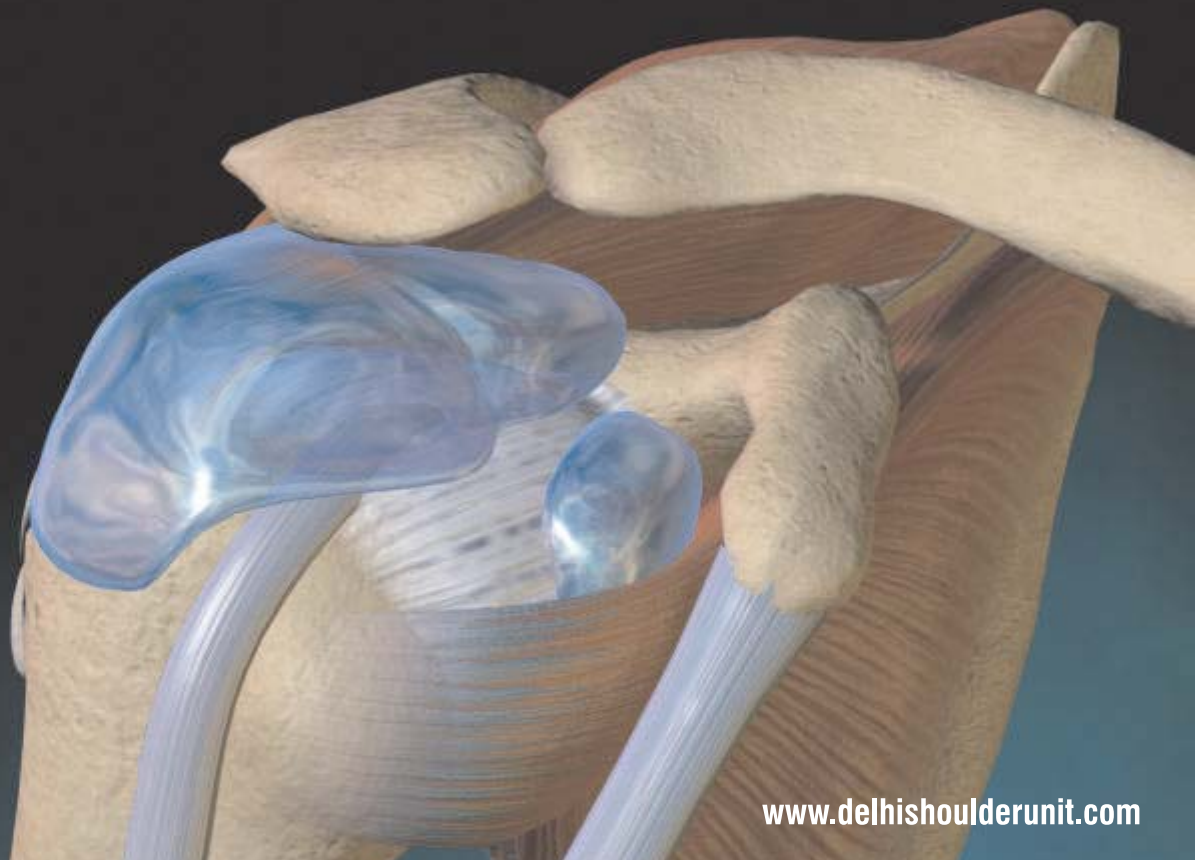

OVERSEAS FACULTY



Dr. Kapil Kumar did his basic and higher surgical training in Aberdeen, UK. He was awarded MCh(Orth) from the University of Aberdeen in 1997, and FRCS (Tr&Orth) in 2004. He has been working as a Consultant Orthopaedic

Surgeon at Aberdeen Royal Infirmary, Woodend Hospital and BMI Albyn Hospital in Aberdeen in Scotland. His practice is focused on Shoulder surgery.

He had previously done his fellowship with Mr. Stephen Copeland and Mr. Ofer Levy at the Reading Shoulder Unit, UK. He has also done a fellowship in Wrightington Hospital, Wigan UK where he worked with Ian Trail and John Haines. Both of these centres are recognized internationally for shoulder and upper limb surgery.

He has presented at various national and international meetings, and has published many scientific papers.



Prof. Levy did his initial training and most of his research in Israel. He developed an interest in Shoulder Surgery very early on in his career which he developed further in UK.

Since 1997 he has been working with Stephen Copeland. In 1999, he was appointed Consultant Orthopaedic

Surgeon at the Royal Berkshire Hospital and in the same year he and Stephen Copeland established the Shoulder Surgery Unit at The Berkshire Independent Hospital. He is a founder member of the Israeli Shoulder and Elbow Society, a member of the European Society of Shoulder and Elbow Surgery and the British Elbow and Shoulder Society (BESS) and Corresponding member of the American Shoulder and Elbow Society.

Professor Associate, the Orthopaedic Research and Learning Centre in the School of Engineering and Design, Brunel University, West London.

He has published many scientific papers, written chapters to books on Shoulder Surgery and invited to lecture worldwide.

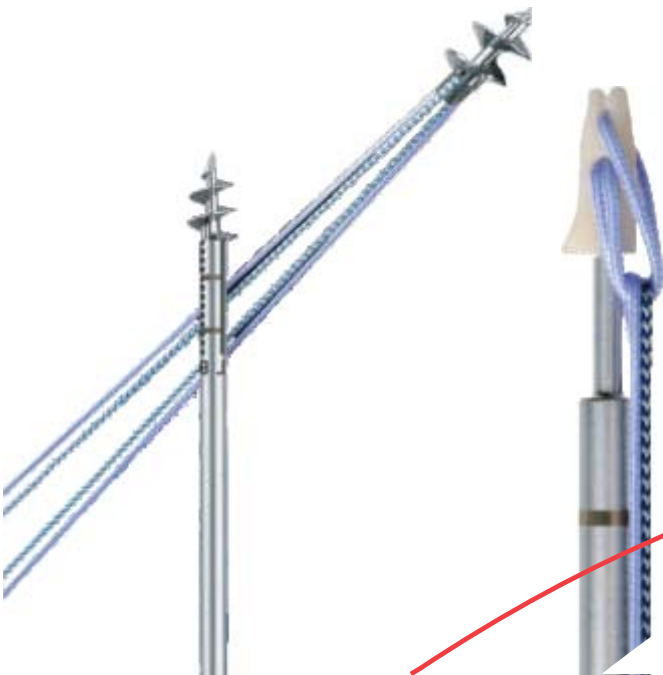
